# Medications at School

It is best for medications to be given at home. When that is not possible, medication can be given at school.

- Prescription Medications (including epi-pens and inhalers):
  - General Medication Administration Form MUST be completed and signed by the doctor and the parent/guardian before any medication can be given at school.
  - Medication MUST be in the original container.
  - Students are not permitted to carry their own medications unless it is an emergency medication, and authorized by their doctor with documentation is on file
- Over-the-Counter (OTC) Medications:
  - o For students to receive any OTC medications, complete the section in Final Forms.
  - o Non-medicinal measures will be provided as the first line of treatment, before administration of OTC medication.
  - Students are not permitted to carry their own OTC medications.
- **Special Diets and Medical Treatments** 
  - Students with special diets such as pureed foods, tube feedings, thickened liquids, food allergies or intolerances, etc., OR, need medical treatments, must have a doctor's note on file detailing what must be done at school-if anything- to accommodate the students needs.
