We would like to honor and thank all veterans and our emergency service personnel who help protect and serve our community.

In memory of Joe Bobo, who suddenly passed away on December 2, 2021, the Eastern Knox County Joint Fire Department honored him on October 9, 2022. As an original board member of the Fire Board and was instrumental in forming the fire district from volunteer to two full-time fire houses, they honored him. He was passionate about working with the fire departments and raising funds, which in turn enabled them to purchase equipment to help save lives in our community. Chief Stimpert and the Fire Board dedicated the newest Medic #433 (ambulance) to him. The inscription on Medic #433 reads "Dedicated in Memory of Joe Bobo for his Several Years of Public Service to EKCJFD".


FOOTBALL
