As of today, Knox County is currently at Yellow Level 1 regarding the state's Risk Level Guidance. If we remain Level 1 or Orange Level 2 as a county, East Knox Local Schools plans to open fully this Fall with safety precautions in place. We consider this Green = Go!

If the county moves to Red Level 3 we will go to our Red Phase, which is a Remote learning plan. Students will not be in the building. Staff will report to the building.

If Knox county goes to Purple Level 4 we will close the school building and have remote learning from home.

If families elect not to send children back to school in person and would like to choose full time online learning for their child the student will be enrolled for a full semester commitment.

Constants

While we hope to open in Yellow or Orange, we must be ready to transition to Red at any time. This requires us to shift to a new, more fluid way of doing school. Our goal is for every child grade KG-6 to use their assigned Chromebook or iPad. Students K-2 will be using iPads. These devices will be sent home during the Red phase if needed. Families who prefer to use their own devices may continue to do so for online learning at home. We have streamlined our online access to educational programs through a site called Class Link that can be used on any device. It is a one stop hub for all our online tools and will function as a student's online backpack for each class.

Facility Preparations

Updated Cleaning protocols are in place for the building and grounds Increased signage will be installed within the building We have purchased PPE & reviewed social distancing needs and space usage Library use will be based on a schedule set by the librarian Hand sanitizers are being installed in several locations We need to teach protocols to students in regard to restroom use, locker visits, hallway usage, lunch areas and basic overall Social Distancing. When should staff come to school or stay home based on symptoms? When should students come to school or stay home based on symptoms?

Individual must stay home until 14 days after last exposure

What should staff and students do if they are sick?

Stay home until symptom free for 48 hours.

What if a student or staff member becomes ill while at school?

They will be assessed by the nursing staff to determine symptoms. The determination as to whether an individual will be sent home will be made at this time.

When can an individual return after COVID illness?

They are free of fever (without the use of medication) and symptom free for at least 48 hours If testing is readily available, individual with a COVID+ test but no symptoms may return to school after <u>all</u> of the following has occurred:

They continue to have no symptoms 10 days have passed since the positive test. Your local health department has released you to return to work or school.

Note: The local Health Department in cooperation with school employees will inform staff and families of students who have had close contact with a diagnosed COVID+ individual (while maintaining confidentiality consistent with applicable state and federal law) to stay home and self-monitor symptoms.

Where will sick students or staff be held until they leave the school? All sick students will be held in the clinic or other authorized quarantined areas. Students being sent home for symptoms MUST be picked up within 30 minutes of being contacted by the school via Class Dojo or Phone call.

Will the nurse/aide go to students instead of the students coming to the office? The raveling of students to the clinic or the nurse going to the student in the classroom, will be handled on a case by case basis and will be at the discretion of the health consultant.

As masks are mandated by the state of Ohio, we ask each student to comply with this regulation.

Enrichment Activities

We will not be having any school sponsored Field Trips for at least the first semester, if not all school year, out of concern for the safety of our students and staff.

Parents can communicate with teachers via school email, Class Dojo, phone calls. Administrators can be contacted via email and phone calls.

Information Technology

Chromebooks only go home at the initiation of the Red Phase. Students will access instructional applications via the Classlink Single Sign-On Portal, Google Landing page, Google Classroom, Google Sites.

Student Arrival

Students in K-3 will go directly to their classroom.

Students in 4-12 will go to the kitchen to pick up their breakfast and the report to their classrooms.

Grab and go breakfasts will be eaten in classrooms.
