I. Grading

You will receive the following amount of points for each assignment:

- 5** – Daily Participation and Materials (Checked Daily)
- 5** – Small Listeners
- 20** – In Class Work and Instrument Assignments
- 20** – Large Listening Activities
- 60** – Projects

In order to receive 100% credit for an assignment, the assignment **MUST** be turned in to Mrs. Jancura at the time requested. After Mrs. Jancura has collected all work, the following points will be deducted:

- Minus 10% after collection to 1 day late
- Minus 20% 2 days late
- Minus 30% 3 days late
- Minus 100% 4 days and later

II. Classroom Expectations

1. Be respectful to every person, thing, and idea.

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III. Consequences

V. Attendance and Missed Assignments

If you are absent, **you** are responsible for getting makeup assignments from Mrs. Jancura. Please get missing assignments before class, after class, or during Mrs. Jancura's planning (last period). Do not interrupt Mrs. Jancura's other classes.

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VI. Restroom and Water Fountain

1. No one will be allowed to leave the classroom the first 10 minutes or last 10 minutes of class.
2. Only one person will be allowed to leave the room at a time.
3. Take the pass and sign out. False information will revoke privileges.
4. 3 passes per quarter

VII. Cell Phones and Electronic Devices

East Knox students are **NOT** permitted to have cell phones or electronic devices according to the student handbook. If it is **seen**, it will be taken to the office. Students can pick up their device from the office at the end of the school day. It does not matter if it was being used or just sitting on their stand. Keep it in your pocket or book bag.

VIII. Tardies

If a student is tardy (not in their seats after the tardy bell has rung), they are to report to the office for a late pass. 50% of that day's participation will be lost due to a tardy.

Mrs. Jancura **WILL NOT** give you an excuse to be late. You are required to have your stuff when you walk through the doors. I will not give permission to retrieve missing materials from your locker after the tardy bell has rung. This is a lesson in responsibility.
