

CES CREDIT UNION SCHOLARSHIP

CES Credit Union offers **two** scholarships of **\$1,000** each for members and member dependents of CES Credit Union entering an accredited two-year or four-year college/university.

Applications are due

Friday, March 15th, 2019

A panel of judges will select the scholarship winners. The judges' decision will be final. The two winners will be notified by April 12th, 2019.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

This scholarship is based on the following five criteria:

- Scholastic ability
- Future plans
- Community service
- Video essay OR written essay
- U.S. citizenship

You must meet the following requirements to be eligible for this educational assistance program:

- 1. Must be a U.S. citizen.
- 2. Must be a member or dependent child or legal ward of a member of CES Credit Union.
- 3. Currently accepted at an accredited two-or four-year college/university, and registering for full-time study.
- 4. Must be a high school senior or recent high school graduate/high school graduate equivalent.

REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

- An official transcript of grades for the most recent two reporting periods from the high school you are currently/last enrolled in.
- A video essay based on the following theme: How have you made a positive impact on your local community? (Must be 2-7 minutes in length.) This video will be weighted towards content and creativity, not technical quality. Video submission may be done via DVD, Flash-drive or a clearly listed YouTube address link.
- OR **A written essay** based on the following topic: How have you made a positive impact on your local community? (Must be a minimum of **500** words in length, typed and double-spaced.) Insert one copy of the essay in your application packet.
- A brief summary: Including any and all extra curricular activities you have been involved in the
 last two years, key accomplishments you've achieved, your work history (if you have any), and
 what your career goals are upon graduating. (Your responses should be typed on a separate,
 double-spaced page.)
- A copy of your U.S. Birth Certificate or U.S. Naturalization Certificate
- A letter of recommendation from a school counselor, business/community leader, teacher or religious leader. You must include the provider's printed name, title and phone number.

Application packets must be <u>postmarked by Friday, March 15th, 2019</u>. Membership will be verified before scholarship funds are awarded. Unsigned or otherwise incomplete applications or applications without required materials will be rejected by the panel of judges.
