- Students are strongly advised to type responses, or to complete and print out the PDF Form Version (Adobe Reader) of this application on a computer.
- By using Adobe Reader, you will be able to fill in the blanks giving a neat typed appearance when it is printed. Adobe is a free software program that can be downloaded from Adobe.com.
 - To move from block to block, type in the required information and tab to the next block
 - Fields which require a check-mark can be so indicated with a mouse click or by pressing the space bar. Click your mouse a second time, or hit the space bar again, to remove a check-mark.
 - The Personal Statement block has been formatted to allow you to type in the one paragraph statement "describing your interests in education and your future plans". (Note: you can copy and paste from a word document into Adobe).
- Using the free version of Adobe Reader, you will not be able to save your work. It is therefore important that you make all revisions and print the form before closing the file on your computer.
- When completed, submit your application, with the Confidential Scholarship Recommendation, to your Guidance Counselor.
