Grandparents Educational Rights:

Under Ohio law, two legal documents — a grandparent power of attorney (POA) and a caretaker authorization affidavit (CTA) — make it possible for grandparents with a grandchild living with them to enroll the grandchild in school and make other educational decisions for the child. These must be filed with the Juvenile Courts, prior to us enrolling the child.

- 1. Fill out new student application.
- 2. Provide proof of address (Utility bill, lease, mortgage or government mailing) and driver's license or proof of identity.
- 3. File documents with Knox County Juvenile Court, 111 E High St, Mt Vernon, OH 43050, 740-393-6798.
- 4. Provide a copy of Grandparent POA & CTA for East Knox.
